

How to host a Community Saints Hamper Day

Bring your community together this Christmas to give back in a meaningful way.





The Saintly Crew Experience

By hosting a Community Saints Hamper Day, you and your group can help fill hampers that bring joy, dignity, and hope to people rebuilding their lives after homelessness.

We've broken it down to simple steps to help guide you!

Step 1 - Gather your Group

Bring together your church, neighbours, bookclub, or friendship group. Decide on a date and location for your Community Saints Hamper Day. You'll need a space large enough for people to gather and pack the hampers together.

Step 2 - Register Your Event

Contact St Bart's to book in your Hamper Day. Each participant contributes \$25, which gifts one hamper to someone supported by St Bart's and covers all items to be packed. Once registered, we'll confirm your booking and provide details for your group's delivery.*

Step 3 – Receive Your Hamper Kit

We'll deliver everything you need for your hamper-packing event, including:

- All items needed to fill the hampers
- A list of contents and instructions
- Cards for personal messages
- A short profile of the group of people your hampers will support for example, older men, women, or families

You'll also receive background stories to help your group connect with the purpose behind the hampers.

* Please note: We do understand that maybe not everyone will be able to afford the \$25. For ease of organizing and being able to bring this to fruition, we will need a minimum of \$500 to be able to bring the bags and items to your venue.





Step 4 – Pack Your Hampers

Gather your group and enjoy the experience of packing together. Add your personal messages or Christmas wishes to the provided cards. You'll be making a tangible difference in someone's life this Christmas while sharing a heartwarming activity with your community.

Step 5 – Return or Arrange Collection

Once your hampers are packed, you can either:

- Arrange for your group to deliver them to St Bart's during business hours, or
- Contact us to arrange collection.

If your group is able to deliver the hampers, it's a wonderful opportunity to see where your kindness will make an impact, but we understand this may not always be possible.

Step 6 – Share and Inspire

Take a group photo (without branded items or alcohol, please) and share your experience to inspire others to become Community Saints.

Encourage others in your community to host their own Hamper Day – together we can fill all the hampers and spread joy across Perth.
